Opening picture from camera

Once you have your picture in your computer, right click on it and select - OPEN WITH then select PAINT

Editing the picture


Now that it is open in PAINT, you can do a lot of things to it. Correct the orientation, change the size and print something on it. The list goes on.

Save your picture

When you have finished editing your picture, give a name and save it in your computer.

Uploading your picture

To upload your picture, go to the ' Attach File ' and click on 'Choose File'. Select your picture and click 'Upload File'
